If your child is enrolled in the Kansas Medicaid TA Waiver program, Kansas Medicaid is allowing payments to parents/family caregivers as personal care service (PCS) workers throughout the COVID 19 emergency period. Please reach out to your Managed Care Organization (MCO) Care Coordinator through your KanCare provider. KanCare providers and contact numbers can be found at www.kdads.gov Helpers Inc. can also help with helping you become a PCS. Their website is www.helpersinc.org. For more information, please email maria@helpersinc.org Kansas is allowing this through May 1, 2020 and will be revisited for an extension, if necessary.

If you participate in the Kansas WIC program you will continue to receive benefits without a physical presence effective March 23, 2020 to May 31, 2020. Please contact your local WIC office for further direction.
